Ungooroo Aboriginal Corporation has worked to empower our Aboriginal community since 1994. Based on Wanaruah country, we have built strong community and industry relationships that allow us to assist the Upper Hunter community to achieve their vision for the future.

We are a multifaceted organisation that provide services including GP and allied health supports, NDIS Provider, Specialist Homelessness Services for young people, Business Services, Wattaka Café, Integrated Team Care Program, Mental Health Program, Barranggirra Program and Ungooroo's most recent Permanency Support Program (Yuti – Guide, show the way).

Ungooroo's Yuti Program is responsible for the case management of Aboriginal Children and Young People in Statutory Out of Home Care (OOHC) referred to as Permanency Support Program (PSP). Ungooroo achieved provisional accreditation with the NSW Office of the Children's Guardian in 2022 to enable Case management of up to 35 children.

The program aligns with the placement principles in finding a suitable permanency placement for all our Children and Young People, including Restoration, Guardianship and Long-Term Care.



All children and young people are placed with Foster Carers and/or kinship carers in the Wanaruah, Kamilaroi, Worimi, Geawegal Awabakal and Wiradjuri country.

who help form a dedicated wrap around service to our Children and Young people and Carers.

As an Aboriginal organisation Ungooroo's Yuti Program is dedicated and committed to keeping Aboriginal Children and Young People connected to their culture and community.

All our Children and Young People have Cultural Plans to help gain an understanding of their mob, who they are, where they come from, how they can participate and engage in community.

This forms a fundamental part of their story, identity and life.

So why choose Ungooroo? We believe our point of difference is providing intensive wrap around support through a cultural lens while acknowledging everyone's unique journey.

Ungooroo works collaboratively with community to achieve positive outcomes for our staff, families, children and young people and carers.
