Our overarching goal is to help the Aboriginal community in the Upper Hunter and across regional NSW to have equal access and outcomes in education, training, employment, and economic participation as the broader community. Permanency Support Program

Ungooroo Aboriginal Corporation is now accredited with the Office of the Children's Guardian to provide support to Aboriginal children and young people through the Permanency Support Program.

The Permanency Support Program (PSP) is supported by a team of experienced caseworkers and carer engagement officers who will work with children, young people and their carers so they can grow up in stable, secure and loving homes.

Ungooroo Chief Executive Officer Taasha Layer says the program plays

a crucial role in providing positive life outcomes for Aboriginal children and young people.

"Our priority is keeping families together safely and achieving permanency for Aboriginal children and young people.

We know that vulnerable Aboriginal children and young people are much better off if they are living in a safe and stable home with relatives or kin, in community and on Country."
