

Ungooroo Aboriginal Corporation has worked to empower our Indigenous community since 1994. Based on Wannaruah country, we have built strong community and industry relationships that allow us to assist the Upper Hunter Indigenous community to achieve their vision for the future. We remain the only Indigenous not-for-profit shopfront organisation in Singleton.



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Ungooroo Aboriginal Corporation (UAC) core values are to inclusively support the whole of the community through providing a range of services such as health, youth support, Aged Care programs, training and employment opportunities, Aboriginal art and tourism, economic development and social inclusion services including NDIS and Mental Health Programs.

We work with our Indigenous community to:

- improve the health of Indigenous people
- increase skills, training, education and employment
- help our community members to achieve personal and financial goals
- · ensure social justice and social equality
- maximise participation in all aspects of community life

The Integrated Team Care (ITC) Program provides an Aboriginal Care Coordinator and Aboriginal Outreach Worker that can help Aboriginal clients/ patients who have Chronic health conditions by providing practical clinical/non-clinical support and assistance in:

- Support attending appointments with local General Practitioners and other specialised professionals
- Follow- up care
- Assisting with completing forms (if needed)
- Initial consultation for Aboriginal community members in Singleton and Muswellbrook who suffer from a range of complex chronic disease issues
- Support for their ongoing health plans
- Engagement with specialists and specialist services
- Provides a clinically trained care coordinator
- Provides an Aboriginal Outreach worker

- This large-scale national program is designed to connect Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elders and older people in our community with the services and supports they need
- This Elders Support Program will ensure older Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and their families are supported to understand, navigate, and access aged care services they are entitled to
- Ungooroo Aboriginal Corporation will provide an experienced Elder Care Coordinator and an Elder Care Connector
- These roles will connect with local Elders, older Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, their carers and families to raise awareness of aged care services. They will help to identify the level of local demand and identify clients who are eligible to access aged care services

UAC supports our communities social and emotional wellbeing through the Kawuma Miruma – Suicide Prevention program. Kawuma Miruma is Ungooroo's suicide Prevention and mental wellness culturally appropriate program supporting the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities in the Singleton and Muswellbrook area. Members and community can access support through:

- Yarning Groups to share and exchange information with others impacted by mental health.
- Support to self assess your stress risk factors to ensure that referral to acute care is timely.
- Group discussion and workshops to better identify and understand your mental health and supports available.
- O Support sessions.
- Supported access to supplementary services.

Wiyala Ngarra is a 12-week psychosocial group for people looking to develop knowledge and skills to enhance their mental health. The group will include psycho-education, assist clients to develop coping skills, reduce stress, increase self-esteem, and achieve insight. The group will cover the following topics:

- Understanding good mental health and wellbeing and how to work towards it.
- Exploring values, beliefs and attitudes.
- Goal setting, making changes and future planning.
- Suicide prevention and safety planning.
- Understanding sadness and depression and expressing loss and grief.
- Substance use and making changes: Nicotine, alcohol &/or illicit substances.

Kayku Kuri Wiyala – Strong Men Speak Together brings our young men together in a culturally safe and supportive group setting. This 7-week program is facilitated by our Specialist Homelessness Service (SHS) team and provides participants with mental and physical wellbeing, employment mentoring and cultural connection. Activities in the program include:

- Yarning groups
- Free health checks
- Cultural activities including dance and didge workshops
- Support in collating personal documentation
- Employment mentoring and support through the Barranggirra team.
