This large-scale, national program is designed to provide culturally safe, holistic support for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander patients throughout the cancer journey.

The Cancer Care Program will ensure that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander patients with cancer are comprehensively supported to navigate the practical, medical, and psychosocial challenges involved with cancer.

What can the Cancer Care Coordinator do for you?

- Assist patients navigating cancer.
- Help patients understand complex cancer-related information and treatment options.
- Act as an advocate for patients within the broader care team.
- Provide social and emotional support to patients and their families.
- Assist in coordinating referrals to additional programs such as Elder Support, Aged Care Support, and Disability Support.
- Collaborate with other healthcare professionals to ensure care is cohesive, culturally safe, and optimised.
- Assist patients to manage appointments, documentation, transport, and other practical challenges associated with cancer.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.
- Have received a cancer diagnosis.
