Specialist care now closer to home.

Accessing specialist health care in the Upper Hunter is now easier thanks to Ungooroo's new Specialist Health Hub in Singleton.

The purpose-built Hub offers modern consulting rooms and advanced telehealth technology, making it easier for patients to connect with specialist services without having to travel.

Ungooroo Chief Executive Officer, Taasha Layer, says delivering specialist care for patients locally helps improve access and long-term health outcomes.

"When specialists are located far away, many people put off getting the care they need because of the time, cost and travel involved. We built the Hub to remove those barriers by bringing services closer to home," Ms Layer said.

"We're committed to achieving the best possible health outcomes for our community. The Hub allows us to provide care that is accessible, coordinated and close to home."

The new Specialist Health Hub is co-located with Ungooroo GP and allied health services and PRP Imaging, creating a connected health care precinct within the Singleton Centre.

Ms Layer said having multiple health services in one location offer significant benefits for patients.

"Being able to see a GP, access allied health services, attend specialist appointments and have imaging completed in the one precinct saves time and improves the coordination of care.

We're making healthcare simpler for our mob and community by bringing

services together in one easy to access location," said Ms Layer.

The Specialist Hub is supported by Ungooroo-trained administration staff and qualified nurses, ensuring patients receive a seamless service from appointment to follow-up care.

Construction of the Hub has been made possible with the support of the Australian Government and Glencore.

GP OUTREACH CLINIC RETURNS TO MUSWELLBROOK

Accessing GP services is now easier for the Upper Hunter community with Ungooroo's free GP Outreach Clinic providing regular, culturally safe holistic healthcare services in Muswellbrook.

Operating from the Outpatient Department at Muswellbrook Hospital, the clinic is supported by Ungooroo's dedicated clinical and administration teams and offers a range of free bulk-billed primary healthcare services.

The free bulk-billing clinic offers a range of services including:

- 715 Aboriginal Health Assessments
- Chronic disease care
- Health care for all ages
- General consultations
- Immunisations
- Cervical screening
- Older person/elder health care
- Wound care
- Lung function tests
- Pregnancy and antenatal care.

Ungooroo Chief Executive Officer, Taasha Layer, says the outreach clinic is part of Ungooroo's ongoing commitment to improving access to healthcare.

"By providing healthcare services in Muswellbrook, we're helping to reduce barriers to care and making it easier for community to stay connected with the healthcare they need.

We take a holistic approach to healthcare, supporting physical health as well as social and emotional wellbeing. Regular health checks and preventative care helps identify potential health concerns early so our patients can access treatment and support before conditions become more serious," explained Ms Layer.

The clinic operates every second Tuesday from 10am to 4pm at the Outpatient Department, Muswellbrook Hospital.

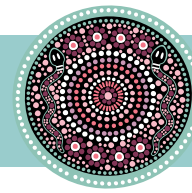

Our Elder Care Support team has been busy over the past few months bringing our Elders and community members together through a range of events that focus on connection, wellbeing, culture and practical support.

In February, we held our Puwama Ngarrakal morning tea to reconnect after the Christmas break over a relaxed morning of yarns and native-flavoured treats.

March was just as special, with two Seniors Festival events bringing Elders and community together. Our art therapy session explored how stories

are shared through art, including learning about the meaning of symbols and how they connect to culture and lived experience. We also hosted a native flavours morning tea where participants learned about the many uses of native ingredients such as lemon myrtle, pepperberry, strawberry gum.

We're looking forward to upcoming events with more morning teas and a special session with Dementia Australia and Carer Gateway planned for July.

The Elder Care Support Program provides culturally safe, community-led support that brings Elders together, strengthens wellbeing, and ensures access to important information and services.

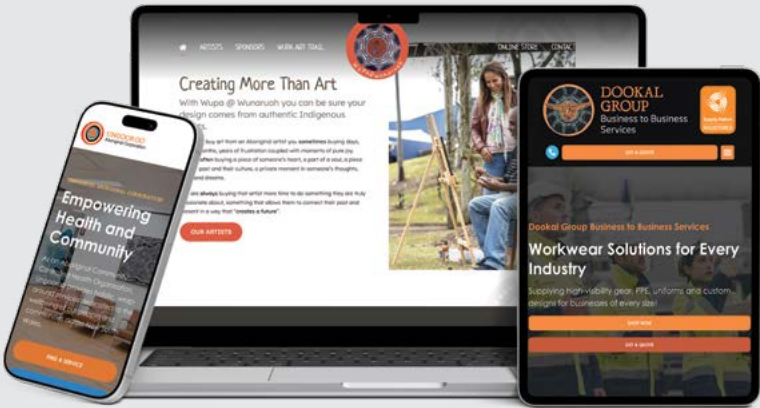

- Free health checks
- Cultural activities including dance and didgeridoo workshops
- Support with important personal documentation
- Employment mentoring and pathways support through the Barranggirra team, helping young men work towards their future goals.

SUPPORTING SAFE HOUSING AND STRONGER FUTURES

We're excited to share that Ungooroo's Specialist Homelessness Service (SHS) **has secured funding for another five years**, allowing us to continue supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people across the Upper and Lower Hunter who are experiencing homelessness or are at risk of homelessness.

For many young people, housing challenges can affect every part of life, from education and employment to health, wellbeing and connection to community. The Specialist Homelessness Service offers early intervention, outreach, casework, advocacy and practical support. The team work to empower our young people by providing opportunities and pathways to build the skills they need to address homelessness in a safe and supportive environment.

We're proud to continue delivering this important service, supporting more young people and families in our community.

CERVICAL SCREENING SAVES LIVES



Our Cervical Screening participation rate is now sitting at 75%! The clinical team are boasting an enormous jump from 34.69% in the third quarter of last year which is a fantastic achievement!! Well done to Holly and the clinical team in making this important screening available to all out patients.

Holly and the clinical team are continuing to ensure every eligible woman is offered the opportunity to have a cervical screening test during her visit. Next week, Sonia & Holly will also be sharing some information on Women's Business at our Women's Yarning Circle, including information about cervical screening & why it matters.

Our amazing clinical team are waiting for some beautiful modesty shawls

featuring Aboriginal artwork to offer our Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander women during cervical screening. We're hoping the shawls will help make the experience even more culturally safe, comfortable & encourage more women to take up this important screening opportunity. **If you would like to book in for a Cervical Screening Test (CST), please contact the admin team to make an appointment on 02 6571 5111.**

PROTECT THEIR FUTURE WITH A SIMPLE NASAL VACCINE

This year we introduced FluMist as a needle-free alternative to the traditional flu vaccination. All children aged 2 to 17 are eligible for free FluMist to protect them from influenza this winter. We've temporarily exhausted our supply but are currently awaiting new stock & look forward to being able to offer again soon. **If you would like further information about when our supply will be replaced, please call our admin team on 02 6571 5111.**

The Barranggirra Program is continuing to go from strength to strength, supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander learners, employers, and training organisations across the Hunter, Mid North Coast, and North Coast regions.

Funded by the NSW Government, Barranggirra provides end-to-end, culturally safe mentoring and support to help learners successfully engage in vocational education and

training, complete their qualifications and transition into meaningful employment.

For participants, support from the Barranggirra team can make a real difference. Having a dedicated mentor means having someone to talk to, check in with and work through challenges that may come up during their training or work. This support help learners stay engaged and focused on their goals.

Brennita was supported by the Barranggirra team throughout her traineeship and is now focused on further education with early entry into university.

Brennita also came first in her visual arts class and had the honour of having one of her artworks displayed at the Coffs Harbour Art Gallery. During her final year of school Brennita also became School Captain, highlighting her leadership skills and dedication.

We're confident Brennita will continue to achieve her goals and excel with her continuing education.

We hope our Elders treasure the day, and their portraits, for years to come."

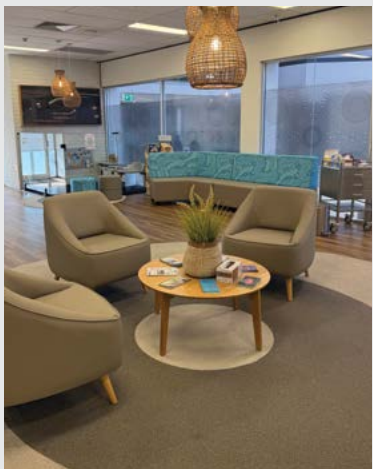
